



The St. Mary's Northern Loop

Circular Walk

Quaint and rural, St. Mary is a peaceful parish. Its north boundary emerges at the coast of jutting cliffs with contrasting colourful blooms in spring and early summer. Inhale the fresh air on the breezy north coast cliff paths and immerse yourself in Jersey's history at the Grève de Lecq Barracks built at the height of fears of a Napoleonic Invasion, one of the last standing in Jersey. And of course start and finish your walk right with a pint of Liberation Ale at the St. Mary's pub.


